MWSPE proudly welcomes submissions of artwork by lens-based student artists to exhibit in the DeVries Gallery of the Richmond Center for Visual Arts at Western Michigan University. All submissions are juried by a student peer review panel.

Eligibility

Students enrolled in photo courses in undergraduate, graduate, photo workshops, institutes, museum programs and high schools.

Rules

- 3 submissions per student.
- All artwork must arrive ready-to-hang or display.

Please choose from one of the two submission deadlines.

1. Shipped Artwork:

Artwork MUST Arrive between:

September 13 – September 17, 2010

At Conference Exhibition

Submit your work online

- Create an account at <http://mwspe.slideroom.com> and follow the instructions provided.
- Pay the \$10 Slideroom submission fee and submit up to 3 images per student. Student groups may enter up to 20 slides, but only 3 individual entries per student are allowed (for example: 5 students may enter 3 works each through slideroom and pay a one-time fee of \$10 slideroom submission fee, amounting to a total of 15 entries).

Slideroom submission guidelines

- Name, address, phone, email, all artwork dimensions, medium, and title of submission(s).
- Still image (jpg). Images should be sized around 1024 x 768 px @ 72 ppi.
- Video (mov, wmv, flv). Uploads must be kept under 60MB each.

Delivery of artwork

- All artwork must be clearly labeled with name, address, phone number, email, title, medium, and year.
